**2005 - 2017** Freelance Photographer based in Hong Kong On Assignment For Time Robin carried out a wide range of assignments: Cambodian Refugees, the War in Lebanon, with the Mujhadeen in Afghanistan during the Soviet occupation (1984) and leading teams of photographers during the Philippine Revolt in 1986, the Seoul Olympics in 1988, the Tian An Men incident in 1989 and the fall of Suharto in Indonesia in 1998 and many others. He often served as roving assignment and photo editor.

Over the years he made exclusive portraits of the political and business leaders of Southeast Asia, producing 20 covers for Time, A and Fortune. Among them: Lee Kwan Yew, Mahathir Mohamed, Aung San Suu Kyi, Fidel Ramos, Corazon Aquino, Stan Shen (ACER), Li Ka-shing, Kim Dae Jung, Kim Young Sam and Deng Xiao Ping.

Also on assignment For Life Magazine, Fortune, Paris Match, Elle, New York Magazine, Smithsonian Magazine, Newsweek, Science (AAAS), U. S. News & World Report, London Sunday Times, Far Eastern Economic Review and many others. For thirty years his corporate work was represented by Deborah Brown and Associates, New York. He was contributing photographer on While working for Time Magazine he received many awards for his work in Asia and the Middle East, among them: 1983 World Press Photo Premier Award and the Robert Capa Gold Medal Citation from the Overseas Press Club, both for his work during the war in Lebanon.
